VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY: No video or photography allowed without the

parents, prior to the start of class.

FOOD: Food and drinks (other than water bottles) are not

allowed in the studios. Only water bottles are allowed in lobby. Popcorn, crackers, or crumbly foods are not allowed in the lobby. Other foods in the lobby will be allowed only if the area is picked up, and wrappers and waste are disposed of in the appropriate garbage or

Rules & Policies Of San Ramon Valley Dance Academy

TUITION: 2019 Summer classes run for **7 weeks**, starting June 17th and ending on August 3th. Summer Camps and Intensives are also being offered.

- 3 weeks of tuition, plus the annual registration fee, is due when registering.
- The office must be notified by July 1st if any weeks are to be pro-rated due to vacations, etc. (max of 4 weeks may be pro-rated; pro-rating in full weeks only)
- The last 4 weeks of tuition is due July 8th
 - Tuition is late as of July 22nd; a \$10 late fee will be applied to all unpaid accounts.
 - In addition, a billing fee of \$15 will be applied to unpaid accounts on August 3rd.
- A \$25 fee is charged for all returned checks.
- NO REFUNDS ARE GIVEN ON TUITION.
- The Academy accepts cash, checks, Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express for payment of tuition.
- For your convenience, online payment and auto payment is available and encouraged. Tuition will be charged on the first day of the pay period for those enrolled in auto pay.

DRESS CODE:

Students must be properly attired and groomed to participate in class. NO GUM OR JEWELRY IN CLASS.

•<u>Ballet</u>: Solid color leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. Ballet skirts, ballet sweaters, leg warmers optional. Hair must be securely pulled back in a bun. Adult Ballet Students: Your choice of appropriate dance attire and Ballet shoes.

•<u>Jazz/Contemporary</u>: Any style leotard or dance attire. No clothing may be worn that obstructs the view of the body (baggy t-shirts, pants). Jazz shoes. No street clothes or shoes may be worn. Hair must be securely pulled back.

•Boys Ballet/Jazz: Sweatpants, dance pants, or shorts. T-shirts. Ballet/Jazz shoes.

• Tap: Your choice of appropriate dance attire. Tap shoes.

•Hip Hop: Comfortable workout attire. Tennis shoes.

•Creative Dance (3-4): Girls: Solid color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes.

(4-6): Girls: Solid color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes.

MISSED CLASSES:

The Academy will do its best to provide make-up times for classes missed due to illness or other legitimate excuses. However, attendance is your responsibility and make-up classes are not guaranteed. Make-up classes may not exceed 5, per class. Students must be currently enrolled to attend a make-up class. Make-ups are only allowed within one month of the date of an absence. Make-ups are only allowed for classes that a student is currently enrolled; if a student drops a class, they forfeit any acquired make-ups for the dropped class. Students must check in at the office and obtain a make-up slip before participating in the class. Students may not make-up a class prior to missing a class.

PARKING: Our primary concern is the safety of our students. Parking is available on either side of the Academy or on the street.

CLASS CONDUCT: Students are expected to be quiet in class, pay attention at all

times, and show respect for their teachers. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from

class.

PUNCTUALITY: Admission to class will be denied if a student is more than 10

minutes late. Parents must not drop children off earlier than 15 minutes before their class and students must be picked up immediately following their last class. Parents are subject to a \$15 charge, plus \$1 per minute after 15 minutes, if a child is not picked up in a timely manner. The Academy cannot be

responsible for overseeing students outside of class.
